Ascertain that picking bins are replenished in a timely manner as per protocol. Doublecheck items to verify the accuracy of outgoing orders and ascertain proper packaging to ensure that they remain safe during shipment, including labelling and documenting outgoing shipments.

Compliance: Comply with the warehouse policies, standard operating procedures, and applicable legislation. Ensure that all QHSE (Quality Health & safety Environment) regulations are complied with to ensure safe working conditions and practices within the warehouse and yard. Comply with the security procedures and Safety & Health. Ensure that the warehouse is tidy, cleared from packaging materials and debris and that the warehouse operates in an orderly way. Take
